SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. RULES

All visiting competitors and their guests shall be temporary members of Queen Mary Sailing Club for the duration of the event and shall abide by all Club rules and Bye-Laws.

5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1 There will be a race briefing for the Cherub fleet at 09:30am on Sunday 28th May and for all classes for the Pursuit Race at 9.45am on Monday 29th May.
- 5.2 The schedule of races is set out below: 3 back to back races within club racing for Races 1&2 with an additional Cherub only 3rd race on Sunday, Race 4 is a Pursuit Race on Monday 29th May:

13.0 THE FINISH

- 13.1 For the Cherub class races 1, 2, 3 and 4, after the leading boat has sailed the course and finished, all boats that cross the finish line from the direction of the course from the previous mark will be finished, irrespective of the number of rounds they have sailed. Competitors will be placed in the race based firstly upon the number of rounds completed, and secondly on the finishing order amongst those completing the same number of rounds.
- 13.2 For the Cherub class races 1, 2, 3 and 4, boats failing to cross the finish line within 15 minutes after the first boat has sailed the course and finished will be scored after those finishing who have completed the laps, according to their position at the previous rounding of the leeward mark. Otherwise they will be scored DNF without a hearing. This changes rules 35, A4 and A5.

14. PENALTY SYSTEM

The Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty. This changes rule 44.1

17. SCORING

- 17.1 The Series will be scored using Appendix A4 the Low Point System .
- 17.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 17.3 When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 17.4 When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

20. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the integer of the square root of the number of entries.

31. LOCAL RULES

Adequate personal flotation devices shall be worn by all crew members at all times when afloat, on the pontoons or on the sloping banks and flag Y will not be shown. This changes the preamble to Part 4 and rule 40. Failure to comply with this requirement will result in disqualification without a hearing. This changes rule 63.1.
